



Sub:- Suggestions for review of Master Plan for Delhi 2021.

Sir/Madam,

I am forwarding here with a copy of suggestions received from farmers and landless laborers of Delhi Dehat on the subject cited above for an appropriate action.

The suggestions are as under:

1. Extension of Lal Dora :- If the land or part of land of any village is proposed to be acquired, in such case LAL DORA of that village should be extended on priority basis to accommodate the growing housing needs of farmers and landless laborers of that villages as they are the real owner of the land, and then the remaining land should be used for planned development of Delhi. In such case the farmers would be satisfied and would not raise any objection.
2. The land of Farmers should be acquired at the prevailing market rate or circle rate.
3. Gram Sabha Land is for the welfare and common use of villagers and that should not be acquired under any circumstances at any cost as the farmers and landless laborers are heavily depended over it.
4. Fifteen Percent of the Developed land should be returned to the farmers of the same village in lieu of acquisition of their land. Such policy is in practice in the state of Uttar Pradesh and same policy should be implemented in Delhi also.
5. The Land existing within 500 Mtrs of village abadi should not be acquired as it should be develop by the farmers themselves for the common welfare. If any such land has been

- acquired in any village of Delhi Dehat then it should be de-notified at the earliest without any delay.
6. There should be proper system for awarding a special rehabilitation and resettlement of the farmers from whom the land is acquired.
 7. Fertile, Irrigated and Multi crop land should not be acquired as it creates shortage of food fruits and vegetables in the Nation.
 8. If the acquired land is not utilized within five years of the acquisition of land, then that land should be returned to the farmers without any delay and without any cost.
 9. The alternative plots for rehabilitation of the farmers should be allotted within one year of the acquisition of land in the acquired land of same village and at the same rate on which the land of farmers is acquired without charging any development charge.
 10. Besides the farmers, the landless laborers should also be allotted at least One Plot/Flat for their rehabilitation as the acquisition of land snatches their livelihood and accordingly the only source of income.
 11. The Farmers should be given royalty (pension) in lieu of acquisition of their land at a rate of Rs. 1,00,000 per year per acre for at least 40 years from the date of acquirement of their land. There should be special provision of royalty for landless laborers also at an appropriate rate. The provision of granting royalty to the farmers has been implemented by the Govt. of Haryana and Uttar Pradesh.
 12. All the Major Projects, Plans and/ or Parks, Colleges, Libraries, University which are being carried out on the acquired land of villages, they should be baptized on the name of prestigious persons/landlord of that village.
