Sub: Filling of Suggestion for Consideration & Implementation for the Zonal Development Plan Zone – P II (North Delhi) in the Master Plan of Delhi – 2021 (MPD-2021)

Sir,

I would like to draw your kind attention towards your Draft zonal Development Plan of Zone – P II (North Delhi June, 2008) being approved by the DDA vide item No. 39/2008 dt. 18.06.2008 for inviting objections/suggestions regarding the subject mentioned above.

Reference is invited towards para 7.2 (i), (ii) & (iii) pertaining together with para 9.0 (v) in connection with the identification of mixed uses area as per mixed use regulations.

I would like to submit a few suggestions for the betterment of the living farmers & their associates in the general public interest. Some farmers & their associates have developed & constructed some godowns for keeping their cereal crops and for keeping Bhusa (Crop waste) for their safety of insects & pests which is essential in accordance with the guidelines of the Food Corporation of India in the national Public interest, these godowns have been constructed in our village Hamidpur in laldora & agriculture land adjacent to the village with minor/small scale industries like Dal Mills & Rice Mills etc. along with godowns developed in other adjoining villages of Bakoli, Jindpur & Khampur in this Zone – P II which do not have any adverse affect in rural environment and the same are essentially required to be adjusted/regularized by the local body as per the mixed use regulations of this zone, so that the Farmers & Associates/Villagers of this zone are not disturbed & harmony/peace is maintained in the villages of this area.


Secondly some farmers & villagers are interested to develop Mini – Farm Houses of One acre land which are necessary for the betterment of the village Environment. Hence it is requested that necessary permission for developing Mini – Farm Houses of about One acre land in the green belt of zone P-II adjacent to Haryana Border of NCRT, so that, the healthy environment is maintained in this area.

Further it is necessary to submit that necessary permission kindly be accorded for establishment of Educational Institutions like ITI, Vocational collages in this green belt area of this zone P-II along with some Recreational activities like Hotels, Motels and Restaurants, Guest Houses, so that the standard of this zonal area is upgraded for the betterment of general public.

At last it is requested that the above mentioned suggestions may kindly be considered & adjusted/regularized for general betterment of the farmers/villagers which are necessary for the betterment of this area/zone.

Hoping favorable & immediate consideration in the general public interest.

Subject : Dumping of waste/garbage near Singhu Border in the premises of village Hamidpur, Delhi (in between village Khampur/Singhola and Hamidpur) which will create unhealthy environment and a typical type of nuisance in this area. Regarding change/shifting

Respected Sir,

It is to be submitted that many people of adjoining villages like Bakoli, Khampur, Tikri, Singhu, Singhola, Alipur, Bhorgarh, Jindpur, Mukmelpur, Bakhtawarpur, Tajpur, Majra, Hiranki, Palla, Great Gurudwara of Dhaula Kuan near Sameypur, Great Temple of Jains near Budpur village, Garhi of Haryana and the town of Narela alongwith Bankner etc. have been horrified that the Delhi Govt. is planning to dump the garbage/waste of Delhi in the premises of village Hamidpur between the area placed on the bank of a Nallah separating village Khampur from Hamidpur which is a very serious problem as per the observations of above mentioned villages due to which the environment and the peace of this area is bound to be spoiled and the habitants of this area are being placed in the pool of unhygienic environment and the same is hereby submitted for your kind consideration is view of the following observations of all these villages.

1. All these villages are situated near the Singhu Border of Delhi on the Highway No. 1 and just on the border at Singhu village a very important pilgrimage of Sikh religion in the name of Guru Gobind Singh/Maharaja Ranjeet Singh and the same has been inaugurated by Shri Rahul Gandhi in the recent past during the year 2011 and the same is being looked after by the Archeological Survey of India where the Sikh of Delhi as well as of the country do have full faith in this. If the waste/garbage is dumped at the proposed area near Hamidpur village. it would spoil the monument of

- Maharaja Ranjeet Singh which has been recently inaugurated and required to be preserved as nistorical monument is bound to be wasted. Hence it needs reconsideration and the garbage is required to be dumped in some other corner of Delhi in the east, west or south.
2. At village Khampur All India Radio Station is situated near the recent site of fruit mandi being the part and parcel of Azadpur fruit and vegetable mandi which will be polluted by dumping of the garbage near the sites of fruit mandi and All India Radio Station. An another Radio Station of Delhi is situated near Nangali-Puna will also be polluted by the dumping of garbage at village Hamidpur which needs reconsideration.
 3. (a) The great Highway of India No. 1 leads to Amritsar where the holy Golden Temple is situated and all the Sikh religion people use this highway to approach the Golden Temple which needs reconsideration.
 (b) This Highway No. 1 is the only path leading to holy Vaishno Mata temple located at Katra in Jammu District and the pilgrim of Mata will definitely feel ill in using this road if the waste/garbage is dumped near this highway in the proposed site of village Hamidpur. Hence it requires reconsideration.
 (c) The same Highway No. 1 leads to holy Amarnath of Lord Shiva and the same is annually used by the Shiv Bhagtas at the specific/scheduled period by many many Hindus from all the states of the country, hence the dumping of waste/garbage near the GT Karnal Road is highly objectionable and needs reconsideration.
 4. It is also not out of place to mention that GT Karnal Road is the only road which connect the Punjab, Himachal, Jammu and Kashmir with the great capital of Delhi and with the other states of the country which also justify that it should be reconsidered before the waste/garbage is put on the bank of GT Karnal road with reference to the importance of these states with reference to the locations of above mentioned villages.
 5. It is also necessary to point out that GT Karnal road is the only road which connects our great India with our neighbor PAKISTAN for which Indian Govt. is fully instrumental to improve our relations with Pakistan so that the peace is observed in Asian countries for which it is equally most necessary to avoid dumping waste/garbage near GT Road at the proposed site in village Hamidpur premises.
 6. Lastly, Haryana Govt. is planning to establish a city of education near Singhu Border near Kundli on the side of Sonapat and this dumping of

garbage/waste near Singhu Border would spoil the Scheme of Educational Universities of Haryana which needs immediate on the spot reconsideration in the interest of education of the country including Haryana and some other space in the eastern/southern part of Delhi is required to be searched out as the Buchar Khana of Delhi is also situated in Shahdara Block of Delhi.

During discussion in the meetings of above mentioned villages some senior citizens and ex-Pradhans of the villages observed to struggle at the cost of their respective lives to get the dumping of the garbage/waste near village Hamidpur shifted to some other suitable place in the eastern/southern part of Delhi in the general public interest of the great capital of Delhi which also attract immediate reconsideration on the subject in question.

In view of the facts and circumstances explained above in brief, it is requested his highness to the office of the Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi to kindly look into the matter patiently with reference to the points submitted above and request with folded hands to kindly reconsider to shift this dumping of garbage and waste from this area to some other suitable place in the best interest of Haryana, Pakistan, J & K, Himachal and Punjab in addition to Union Territory of Delhi and the other parts of the country.

Hoping an early and favorable consideration in the general public interest.
