## MPD 2021 AD IN FORCE SINCE FEB., 2007

It is in 18 chapters namely— (1) Regional and Sub-Regional Frame, (2) Population and Employment, (3) Delhi Urban Area 2021, (4) Shelter, (5) Trade and Commerce, (6) Wholesale Trade, (7) Industry, (8) Government Offices, (9) Environment, (10) Conservation of Built Heritage, (11) Urban Design, (13) Social Infrastructure, (14) Physical Infrastructure, (15) Mixed Use Regulations, (16) Land use Plan, (17) Development Code and (18) Plan Review and Monitoring. These 18 chapters will continue as they are, except No. 13. 
