It is a shameful situation for a world-class city, Delhi, that it is not able to meet the basic education requirement. Thus government should focus on these key points in Master plan review:

1. Allot (not auction) new school land to eligible parties.
2. Increase built-up area so that existing schools can cater to more students.
3. Ask schools to open separate/feeder nursery wings to increase capacity.
4. Improve quality of government schools at par with private schools.
5. Double shift in schools.
