Sub – Suggestions on M.P.D.-2021

Respected Sir,

We fully appreciate and support your initiative to prepare basic infrastructure of Delhi to meet the population pressure in the forthcoming years under the M.P.D. 2021 and wish to submit our suggestions as under

1. In order to face lift the main market just opposite the Capital Railway Station and keeping in view the increasing population size no compromise should be made on widening the market roads and by-lanes at Main Bazar, Pahar Ganj, New Delhi.
2. The tourism and local business has been flourished according to traders and hotel owners since the M.C.D. has widened the market roads before CWG 2010.
3. That move was welcomed by general public and foreigner tourists who now feel fresh air to breath and space for free movement.
4. That you ^{should} not surrender before the political interference and protest by the unauthorized occupants or shopkeepers as we noticed last year at Main Bazar, Pahar Ganj, 6 Tooti Chowk
5. That at present Main Bazar is 59 feet wide at Chitra Gupta Road end and about 50 feet wide at Chelmsford Road corner. Then why this has been left 22 to 30 feet wide at 6, Tooti Chowk, shop No. T-374 to Shop No. 5084 where as in your book on M.P.D. it as 18 metres to 13 metres (minimum) wide. This bottle-neck stretch must be widened in the larger interest of Public and Chowk 6, Tooti must be developed as splendid tourist hub.

We hope that you'll give due consideration to the above mentioned facts and suggestions in the wider interest of the residents and the commuters of Pahar Ganj, New Delhi.
