In the plans prepared by DDA whether MPD-2021 AD and Zonal Plans; **no land use is clear except residential**. In earlier plans prepared in last two centuries from 1865 onwards plans were clear due to **FAITHFUL WORKING**. I give only two examples; besides these there are many.

Example No. 1.

Plan of the City of Delhi, surveyed and drawn in the year 1865-66 by Lalas Hurdeo Das and Tika Ram, was in the Scale of 1 Inch = 100 feet.

Example No.2

All the plans of Walled City of Delhi were prepared by TCPO, **Ministry of Health, F.P. Govt. of India in 1960 's**. For example, Zonal Plan of Zone A-14 (Suiwalan area) was prepared in a Scale of 1 Inch = 1000 Feet and **approved on 7**th **August, 1968**.

Against these our latest Zonal Plans prepared and approved in July, 2010 vide MOUD have many minus points. For example, area in the North of Wazirabad road in Zone-E; 6 lakhs population is living since 1985 is shown as Green i.e. uprooting them.

3.1 LAND USE

In scale of 1": 10,000' (1 Inch: Ten Thousand Feet).

Divide the land use plan in following two parts.

Land use.

1. RESIDENTIAL:

(i) Developed area, (ii) Sub-standard area viz. Unauthorized colonies, Unauthorized Regularized colonies, Urban Rural villages, Slum areas, Resettlement colonies, Jhuggi clusters etc.; Foreign Missions.

In the next 10 years 24 lakhs houses have to be constructed with a break up of about 12 lakhs in 11th Five Year Plan and the balance in 12th Five Year Plan. This will be new housing as well as by the method of Re-development in (i) Urban poor through Slum & JJ approaches and (ii) on independent plots, (iii) Group housing, (iv) Employer housing, (v) Unauthorized regularized colonies, and (vi) By up-gradation of old areas and villages.

- 2. COMMERCIAL (Planned & Unplanned).
- 3. UTILITY& SERVICIES Water; Sewerage; Electricity; SWM; Drainage
- 4. GOVERNMENT
- 5. INDUSTRY
- 6. RIDGE/REGIONAL PARK; RECREATIONAL -City Park, District Park, Community Park; Historical Monuments
- 7. **TRANSPORTATION**; Airport; Terminal/Depot-Rail/MRTS/Bus/Truck; Circulation Rail/MRTS/Road
- 8. **PUBLIC & SEMI PUBLIC-** Hospital; Education; Social Cultural; Police, Fire Stations, Disaster Management Centre; Religious Burial Ground/Cremation; Transmission Site /Centre; Sports Facilities

4. POLICY POINTS

There is no doubt that policies given in MPD-2021 are good and <u>if</u> implemented, will make Delhi **the best city of INDIA**; but so far practically nothing has been implemented. **These are as under:**

- i. Re-planning, Re-development and Re-construction; applicable to all Sub-standard areas where 70% population live.
- ii. Public Private Partnership;
- iii. Use of TDR (Transfer of Development Rights)
- iv. Higher FAR along High Intensity Corridors.
- v. Permission of commercial activities on 24M and above roads.
- vi. Adequate parking facilities.
- vii. Full transparency;

IMPORTANT PROJECTS TO BE ADDED.

i. Western Expressway

Kundli-Manesar-Palwal Expressway

It starts from NH-1, cutting across NH-10 then NH-8 and then NH-2. Total length of this corridor is 136 km. There is a proposal to develop of 13 Metro cities along with Kundli Expressway. This will control population of Delhi up to some extent.



This will start from Kundli (Haryana) at the junction of NH-1; Mavikala (On the road) from Delhi to Baghpat; Duhai on NH-58 (from Delhi to Meerut); Dasna (from Delhi to Hapur on NH-24); Beel Akbarpur (on NH-91) from Ghaziabad to Sikandrabad; Bridge on river Yamuna and Palwal on NH-2.







- iii. New bypasses in Delhi to decongest it involving National Highways No.1, 2, 8,
 - UER-I will connect Wazirabad bypass to NH-1, 10 and 8 and will be 57.24 km. long
 - b. UER-II will connect Wazirabad bypass to NH-1, 10, 8 and 2 and will be 73.7 km long
 - c. UER-III will provide connectivity from Wazirabad to NH-1 and 10 and will be 20.8 km. long.

Total 151.74 km.




These 3 bypasses are in NCTD and should be expedited.


