I have added one more point to the earlier Draft. I am attaching the Final Draft if you have already read it then for your convenience I am reproducing the last point in the following text

More Colleges and Schools for Delhi Children: There is a huge short fall of Schools and Colleges in Delhi but DDA only auctions large tracts of land for Private Malls and Swanky Hospitals. Each year there is a mad rush for School and College admissions but no one seems to have any plans in place for our future citizens. It is unfortunate that Planners have not kept in mind the crying need for this basic facility for the Capital City. Today thousands of students come to Delhi adding to the population as also using up scarce College Seats. YES DU is a Central University and as Politicians would say the Capital belongs to all alike, we do not grudge that..... BUT where do the citizens of Delhi go for Higher Education REMEMBER the land on which DU Colleges stand belongs to Delhi.

SUGGESTION: Delhi University, though a Central University sits on Land that belongs to DELHI, special quota must be created for the Domiciles of Delhi. Just like additional seats were added to accommodate OBCs, DU colleges must add capacity to take in Delhi Students FAILING which some part of the huge tracts of land allotted to various DU colleges should be acquired and handed to a University formed to run under Delhi Government or MCD. This is not a unique concept scarce land is at a premium and the changing demographics do not allow the Luxury of running 2000 student colleges on 20 acre land. Three Hindu or Stephens can run out of Land allotted to them GIVE DELHI STUDENTS THEIR SEAT OR TAKE BACK OUR LAND.
