Subject: Review of Master Plan for Delhi 2021 with reference to International Convention Centres in the NCT of Delhi.

Respected Sir,

The Federation of Hotel & Restaurant Associations of India (FHRAI) would once again take this opportunity to convey its sincerest thanks to your goodself for the patient and sympathetic hearing that you have been kind enough to extend to FHRAI representatives whenever they have called upon yourself to bring to your kind notice the problems faced by hotels in the NCT of Delhi, and more recently our suggestions for modifications in the MPD -2021 in response to the Public Notice issued by the Ministry of Urban Development on 18.2.2012 regarding review of the Master Plan for Delhi 2021. In this connection, our following letters refer:-

- Letter dated 27th April, 2012 addressed to your goodself requesting relaxation of parking norms for hotels in the NCT of Delhi.
- (ii) Letter dated 19th March, 2012 addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India requesting enhancement of FAR for hotels in the NCT of Delhi from 225 to 300 and for relaxation of parking norms for hotels in the NCT of Delhi; and

(iii) Letter dated 19th January, 2012 addressed to DDA requesting enhancement of FAR for hotels in the NCT of Delhi and other related issues.

Sir, further to our suggestions made in our above letters we would like to submit that one of the fastest growing segments of the tourism industry in the world is the "Meetings, Incentives, Conferences and Exhibitions" called MICE tourism. Recognizing its importance the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India has set up the India Convention Promotion Bureau to promote this segment and the success of this Bureau depends entirely upon the availability of adequate Convention and Exhibition facilities in the country, which at present are woefully lacking. Simultaneously, it has also framed "Guidelines for approval of Convention Centres", A copy of these guidelines is enclosed for reference.

It will kindly be seen that as per these guidelines, residential accommodation for delegates/participants in the form of star category hotels forms part of a Convention Centre. However, it is seen from Table 13.27 "Socio-Cultural and Community Facilities" of MPD-2021 that the activities permitted in International Convention Centre do not include hotels.

As per this Table, the activities permitted in an International Convention Centre are as under:-

"international convention centre, watch & ward residence (upto 20 sq. mtrs), residential flat (for maintenance staff), restaurant, bank, post & telegraph office, library and exhibition centre".

Sir, it will be pertinent to mention here that internationally, hotel accommodation forms an integral part of a Convention Centre. This is to ensure that, as far as possible, the delegates attending Conferences, Convention and Exhibitions, and other participants find it easy to walk from their respective hotels in the Convention and Exhibition Centre Complex itself instead of staying at other Hotels to which they have to commute.

In view of this position, we request that hotels may also be included in the activities permitted in an International Convention Centre, a use premise which falls under the "Socio-Cultural and Community Facilities" in Table 13.27 of the MPD 2021. The hotel(s) so permitted will form part and parcel of the Convention Centre planned and constructed on a common podium.

We would further like to submit that the 'Development Controls' for Convention and Exhibition Centres and Convention Hotels may also be revised as under:

- (1) Ground Coverage from 30% to 40%
- (2) FAR from 120 to 300
- (3) Parking Standards from 2 ECS to 1.67 ECS per 100 sq. mtrs. of floor area.
- (4) Other Control:
 - (i) Additional 10% ground coverage for atrium of which 25% shall be counted towards FAR.
 - (ii) 20% of the FAR may be used for commercial purposes, as permitted in hotels.

Sir, the FHRAI shall ever remain grateful to your goodself for a favourable and sympathetic consideration of our above suggestions, if the same is agreed to and the modifications in MPD 2021 carried out, then New Delhi could have a World Class Convention and Exhibition Centre with Convention Hotel which could be utilized by the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India and the Prime Minister's office to host G-15 meetings in which Heads of Governments are invited to participate.

It is indeed a said fact that our Hon'ble Prime Minister is invited by various countries in the G-15 to their Meetings held in their countries but India is unable to host such an event in New Delhi because of the lack of such a comprehensive facility.
