We suggest that the provision regarding earmarking of green belt extending to a complete revenue village on the

border be removed. The reasons are as follows

1. No such provision exists in the bordering states like Haryana etc. You are therefore penalising the farmers

in Delhi whose land rtices will not appreciate in villages under green belt.

2. There exist certain commercial structures in such villages like stores etc. These can not be expected to

be removed now.

We suggest that if a green belt must be maintained along the borders of Delhi it may not extend beyond half a kilometer from the border.
