SUBJECT: Few Suggestions To Be Taken Into Consideration Under Master Plan Of Delhi 2021.

I am a responsible citizen of India residing at New Delhi and since past 30 years into property/real estate/construction line.

Through out these years I have gone through all the technicalities of the building bye-laws, attitude of the people in departments like MCD/ DDA etc., hence writing this letter to bring into highlight the loop holes in the Master Plan of Delhi and request you to kindly include the below mentioned few suggestions in the Master Plan of Delhi 2021.

Points to be taken into consideration:

1) In the Master Plan of Delhi 2021 there is no where written/mentioned that the lift opening ^{to be allowed} will not be in basement (so this implies that lift opening can be in basement). MCD also doesn't seems to be clear regarding this as it allowed opening for some time but suddenly stopped it.

Even if a survey is being carried out in Delhi one will find that almost in 100% case lift opening are through basement only. Also practically it is not feasible that one should go from ground floor to stilt via lift and then to go to basement through staircase. Hence clarity should be bought in the master plan of Delhi 2021.

2) Toilet in the basement should be allowed. Earlier its was not feasible but today advancement in technology / technique such as proper sewerage systems, septic tank through which one can easily flushed it outside. In 90% of the building of 300 or above sq.yd in Delhi one can find toilet in basement. Hence it should be allowed and included in the master plan of Delhi 2021.

3) In the Master Plan of Delhi 2021 it is allowed to build atleast four (4) apartments in a building. So, if four apartments are built, there will be four drivers/servants. Hence it is suggested to allow a urinal in stilt for the driver etc., so as to keep the surrounding areas neat & clean by avoiding urinating by the drivers etc.

4) Open Urinal should be allowed in the terrace on building measuring 300 & above sq.yds. Master plan and even MCD also doesn't seem to be clear regarding this, hence suggested to be allowed.

Because of the above mentioned loopholes/ lack of clarity in the master plan, the concerned departments/authority harasses or takes undue advantage at the time of issuing completion certificate.

Hence sincerely request you to take into consideration the above mentioned points/suggestions. Your early action in this regard will be highly appreciated.
