Respected Minister

It was very encouraging to read your comments in the newspapers recently stating that the 2021 Master Plan of Delhi prepared by the DDA has lot of shortcomings and needs to be amended to be in tune with the realities on ground. We hope some action is being taken in this regard.

May I also add the following shortcoming in the functioning of the DDA based on my experience as a member of the Monitoring Committee of the Delhi High Court for over two years during 2006-08 to check unauthorized constructions and encroachment in Delhi:

1. The geographical jurisdiction of the departments of the DDA in the city does not coincide with revenue/police/MCD districts. This creates lot of problems in its effective functioning and coordination.
2. There is no proper record of the lands of DDA encroached by the people in Delhi.
3. There is no effective administrative and legal monitoring and action against illegal constructions on DDA lands, allotted or otherwise, as many departments are involved.

Kindly get these problems also sorted out. I am always available for any further assistance if needed by your good self.
