Dear Shri Nath Sahib,

Shri S. Sinha, senior journalist and noted social activist, had been provided the PCO booth, on the orders of the highest authorities, by the MCD on February 17, 1995 and the same and the same had been functioning on the main road of the INA Market, New Delhi. The PCO Booth had been sanctioned under the physically handicapped quota since he had the serious accident in February 1992 and hospitalization for long four years, making him the physically handicapped.

During DMRC's plan of constructing underground station, he temporary closed the PCO booth so as to ensure that dust etc settles down.

It was shocking to learn that the PCO Booth was demolished and MCD informed that it had no role at all in its demolition and blamed the DMRC to have demolished in order to take over the said site. It is surprising to see that, on the request of several MPs to the highest authorities seeking rehabilitation of Shri Sinha and installing the PCO Booth on the same side, Shri P.S. Chauhan, Chief Engineer/General, DMRC certifies that no PCO booth was demolished by DMRC for Metro work at INA. The DMRC has not taken any land at INA from MCD, therefore, question of demolishing of any PCO Booth by DMRC does not arise (copy enclosed).

During this process of long three years, his wife suffered heart attack, lost both the kidneys and cancer and despite best efforts by the Escorts, Pushpawati Singhania Research Institute and the All India Institute of Medical Sciences. She expired on October 14, 2011 at the AIIMS. The entire blame goes to the MCD officials.

Again regarding allowing the installation of the PCO Booth on the original site, Shri K.S. Mehra, Commissioner, MCD, has directed the D.C. (South) to take appropriate action while the jurisdiction is with the DC (Central Zone) (copy enclosed).

MCD has done irreparable loss to the physically handicapped person, and, again only recently having again dismantled the PCO Booth through a constable.

I request and shall feel highly grateful to you for your very kindly taking strict action against the erring officials. The Police and MCD officials support be kindly ensured so that the PCO Booth gets installed on the original site with immediate.
