RULES & CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The SRFI rules shall apply unless otherwise stated. Players should note the code of conduct and abide by its regulations.
2. A Player can enter in two age categories.
3. A minimum of 8 entries is required to conduct the tournament in any category. In case of inadequate entries in any category, the entries shall be considered for the next age category.
4. Players must be under the age category as on 31 st October 2009. All players are requested to carry documentary proof of age (Passport or Birth Certificate). In the event of any doubt, the SRFI Observer have the right to order a medical test on the player. Medical/X-Ray/ageing proof etc., would be done at the cost of the player.
5. Players are required to report to the tournament office at least 20 minutes before the scheduled starting of their match.
6. All matches shall be played on the best of five games and on 9 point per game scoring system.
7. Squash balls shall be provided by the Tournament Committee.
8. Referees for the matches shall be arranged by the Technical Committee. All players will be expected to act as referee.
9. The Technical Committee reserves the right of refusing any entry without giving any reasons. The decision of the SRFI Observer will in all matters be final including discipline and match adjudication.
10. Copies of the draws for each day's programme will be placed on the notice board at the Squash Courts.
11. All players must be clad in complete WHITE OR PASTEL shades including shoes with WHITE soles and socks.
12. Players will be required to make themselves available to meet reasonable request for interview by the media and to attend official functions connected with the tournament.
13. Players are warned not to air their opinions on any controversial issues & not to make any derogatory remarks about fellow competitors, officials, referees or any related parties.
14. Players may be required to play more than two matches in a day.
15. All participants must compulsorily furnish documentary proof of age. Photocopy of certificate from the Principal of the school/college letter-head be sent along with the entry form, failing which their entries will NOT be accepted. Above 35 years and veterans may submit attested photocopy of driving licence/passport/identity card etc.
16. 17. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the SRFI Observer shall be final and binding.
18. Accommodation or TA/DA will not be provided.
19. Entries will close on Saturday, 28th November, 2009 at 5.00 p.m.
20. Out-station entries must be sent to the SRFI only through the affiliated state associations of the Federation. No direct individual entries will be accepted. Entries can also be sent directly to the Federation through Associate members under section 9(b) of the Constitution viz. Clubs, Schools, Colleges, or other organizations not specified. 21. Entry Fee in cash or in the form of a Demand Draft in favour of "DDA Open Squash Tournament" and drawn on any bank in New Delhi/Delhi must be enclosed with Tournament Entry Form. Entry Fee is as follows:

 - (b) Rs.100/- for above 35 yrs. (Men) above 45 yrs. (Men), Under 19 (Boys), Under 17 (Boys), Under 15 (boys), Under 13 (Boys), Under 11 (Boys), Girls Under 17, Girls Under 15, Girls Under 13 and professionals.
