
**Sub:- Re-imbursment of Cost of medicines tests, et**

Points raised from some quarters in DDA and decisions taken by the Competent Authority with regard to the same are as under :-

<u>S.N.</u>	<u>Points</u>	<u>Decisions</u>
1	The official of the Accounts Branch are simply giving 50% of the charges for blood tests which it cannot find in St. Stephens' rate list	The practice was adopted with the prior approval of the then Finance Member in the year 1998 in the larger interest of the employees claiming medical reimbursement. It has now been decided that where the rates of some items or tests are not available in the rate list of St. Stephens Hospital, the procedure as laid down in CS (MA) Rule 11(11) Section-I [vide G.I. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare O.M. No.S-14021/5/88-MS dated 17.10.1988 shall be followed.
2	In a number of cases medicines for last day of hospitalization / before discharge which are to be used after discharge are not being paid.	It has been decided that the cost of medicines prescribed on the last day of treatment/date of discharge shall be paid.

The above decisions may be implemented by all the concerned staff/officers dealing with medical re-imbursment.
