CIRCULAR

Sub: Reimbursement of the medical expenditure in case of Death of the employee / Pensioner in the hospital.

A number of employees/ Pensioners are expired during the treatment in the Hospital. In case of sudden illness/emergency patients are generally taken to the nearest hospital. Claims in such cases are reimbursed at the St. Stephen Hospital/CGHS rates as per admissibility and substantial amount has to be paid by the employee from their own pocket as the hospitals charges are generally very high. Though in some cases where requests are received by the Competent authority, reimbursement is made in relaxation of the rules by the Competent Authority on the merits of the case yet in many cases especially class IV illiterate staff the family has to bear the amount. To have a uniform policy for the sake of staff welfare, Vice-Chairman has been pleased to order that full reimbursement be allowed, irrespective of the status of the hospital, if the employee / pensioner only (not the spouse or dependent) dies in the hospital during the treatment. Such reimbursement can be allowed by the authority competent as per
