7. The validity of the quotation is 60 days from the date of opening of the sealed quotations.
8. Debarred agency/or individual shall not be permitted to participate in the tendering process.
9. Any individual who has been debarred is not permitted to take part in any negotiations or represent an agency even if he holds a power of attorney on the agencies behalf. Any agency engaging debarred persons is also liable to debarring.
10. The quotationer should be registered with the sales Tax Deptt. (W.C Cell) Govt. of GNCTD and supposed to furnish a copy of Sales Tax Registration (W.C. Cell) & Sales Tax Clearance Certificate and attach the same alongwith quotation otherwise the quotation may not be considered and liable to be rejected.
