F&E CIRCULAR NO. 22/2018

Sub: DDA Medical Scheme - reimbursement of advanced IPD treatments where CGHS codes are not available.

VC, DDA has been pleased to approve following additional benefits as a further welfare measure for DDA Medical Beneficiaries.

1. Treatment taken from Empanelled Hospital

- (i) For Cancer disease, reimbursement for such treatment/procedure may be allowed for which no rates have been prescribed in CGHS or there is no AIIMS rates available. For such reimbursement 10% of expenditure on non codified item will be borne by the beneficiary subject to verification of non availability of CGHS code/AIIMS rates, by Dy.CAO(Medical) & thereafter by TPA. Competent Authority to approve such reimbursement will be CAO, DDA.
- (ii) For other treatments (other than Cancer), reimbursement for such treatment/procedure may be allowed for which no rates have been prescribed in CGHS or there is no AIIMS rates available. For such reimbursement 20% of expenditure on non codified item will be borne by the beneficiary subject to verification of non availability of CGHS code/AIIMS rates, by Dy.CAO(Medical) & thereafter by TPA. Competent Authority to approve such reimbursement will be CAO, DDA.

2. For treatment taken in Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Institute

Beneficiaries may take Cancer treatment in Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Institute after seeking prior permission. For such treatment reimbursement is generally restricted to CGHS rates. However as a welfare measure, 50% expenditure of the treatment over and above the CGHS rates will also be reimbursed and balance 50% will be borne by the beneficiaries. Competent Authority to approve such reimbursement will be CAO, DDA."
