Subject: Approval for temporary allotment of 1000 sqm of vacant land
near Sector B&C, Lohia Colony, New Delhi-110058 from 15/09/01 to 16/09/01 (22 days)

1. The concerned authority has issued a temporary allotment of 2000 sqm of vacant land near Sector B&C, Lohia Colony, New Delhi-110058 from 15/09/01 to 16/09/01 (22 days) for the purpose of the event to be applied.
- a. The concerned authority has issued a Fire Safety Order.
 - b. Fire safety will be ensured by the concerned authority.
 - c. A copy of fire laws 2001 and 2002 issued by concerned authority to the applicant as having accepted the terms of allotment pending the Fire Safety Order.
 - d. Fire permission will be obtained by the concerned authority before start of the event. Fire Safety Committee will also be constituted by the concerned authority. DDA Fire Officer cum Nominated Authority before start of the event. Proper arrangements for firefighting will be made by the concerned authority. The concerned authority will be fully responsible for any mishap like outbreak of fire, damage or any such other thing happened to general public or property occurring during the conduct of the said event. DDA will bear no responsibility for any such onward incident. To check adequacy of fire fighting arrangements, DDA Fire officer may carry out surprise check any time before the start of the event or during the event. Any gross violation of fire safety norms will be immediately brought to the notice of General Chief Engineer who may undertake cancellation of the allotted area by law.
 - e. Local authorities could approach the concerned authority for management of fire risk and cost. They can be held responsible for any damage suffered as a result of any such action taken by them in pursuance of the concerned authority's orders.
 - f. No permit shall be given for the following:
 - i. Tobacco, fireworks, paint, perfume, paint thinner, lacquer.
 - ii. Steel, M.C.C. and other materials which are explosive, inflammable.
 - iii. Firing for dry grass, fire, & fireworks, etc., used for ceremonial.
