Sir, may please collect 4200 sqm of available land for
Approval is hereby accorded to Deeapanwita Cultural Association (Regd) for temporary allotment of 1000 sqm of vacant land beside manish plaza Mall, Sec-22 Dwarka from 26-09-11 to 08-10-11 (13 days only) for organizing Durga Puja. Kindly ensure the following conditions for actual handing over of the site to the applicant:-

- a) Security amount and cleaning charges will be charged from the applicant as per orders.
- b) The organizers will vacate the ground latest by the last day of allotment.
- c) A copy of guide lines duly signed and stamped will be obtained from the applicant as having accepted the terms of allotment prior to actually handing over the site.
- d) Police permission will be obtained by the applicant before start of the event. Fire Safety clearance will also be obtained by the applicant from DDA Fire Officer-cum-Nominated Authority before start of the event. Proper arrangements for firefighting will be made by the event organizers. The organizers will be fully responsible for any mishap like outbreak of fire, stampede or any such other thing injurious to general public or property occurring during the conduct of the said event. DDA will bear no responsibility for any such untoward incident. To check adequacy of fire fighting arrangements, DDA Fire officer may carry out surprise check any time before the start or during the conduct of an event. Any gross violation of fire safety norms will be immediately brought to the notice of Zonal Chief Engineer who may order cancellation of the allotment at his discretion.
- e) The organizers would conduct the function and make entire arrangements at their risk and cost. They shall be fully responsible for any untoward incident or for violation of any rules or guidelines of the Govt. or other controlling agencies.
- f) No commercial activity will be permitted other than the following:-
 - i) Jhotas/Swings permitted: Only two permitted by DDA on free basis.
 - ii) Stalls: NO auction stalls are permitted. Only stalls by organizers permitted.
 - iii) Parking per day: Cars Rs 10/- & Scooters Rs 5/- (If levied by organizers).

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.

Guide Lines for utilization of DDA land for Religious Functions

1. The allotted site will Not be used for any other purpose except for which it has been allotted;
2. No damage will be done to area fencing/wall or any other assets created by DDA on the allotted piece of land. Damages if any, will be made good by the organizers and no future allotments will be made. The security amount will be refunded only once the site is handed back in its original shape;
3. The organizers will make their own arrangements for water and electricity with the concerned Govt. agencies and no unauthorized tapping of electricity or water from any pole or water line will be resorted to during the period of allotment;
4. The organizers will make necessary security arrangements in direct liaison with the local police and DDA will not be responsible for any security lapse/law and order situation arising out of staging the said event;
5. Maintaining public peace, tranquility and safety will be the sole responsibility of the event organizers and DDA will in no way be responsible for it;
6. No unauthorized entry points will be made at the site by breaking the wall/fencing. No addition/alteration to any structure will be made at the allotted ground. For help, a request will be made to the concerned EE/AE/JE/UDA Staff responsible for the area who may consider it at their sole discretion;
7. Loud speakers will be used only as per the laid down guidelines and in consultation with the local police.
8. Proper arrangements for fire fighting will be made by the event organizers. The organizers will take full responsibility for any mishap like outbreak of fire, stampede or any such other thing injurious to general public or property occurring during the conduct of the said event. DDA will not be responsible in any way for any such untoward incident. To check adequacy of fire fighting arrangements, DDA Fire officer may carry out surprise check at any time before the start or during the conduct of an event. Any violation of fire safety norms observed by him will be reported to Zonal Chief Engineer which may ultimately result in cancellation of the allotment. Losses, if any, due to last minute cancellation will be borne by the event organizers and DDA in no way will be responsible for such losses.
9. No activity of any kind will be allowed to take place outside the allotted ground. Eating stall etc. will be located inside the allotted area;
10. The organizers will vacate the ground latest by the last day of allotment.
11. If at anytime, breach of any of the above guidelines is observed, DDA reserves the right to cancel the said allotment of land without assigning any reasons and it shall in no way be responsible for any loss accruing to the organizers as a result of such cancellation. In such an event, the organizer may forfeit the right to similar allotment in future.
12. No bursting of crackers are allowed between 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Fire crackers during the permissible period will adhere to the Noise Pollution control Level as prescribed u/s 31 (A) of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 read along with Rule 20A of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution)(Union Territories) Rules 1983.
13. Generator sets above the capacity of 5 KVA shall not be operated in residential areas between 10.00 p.m. to 6.00 a.m.
14. Generator sets above the capacity of 5 KVA in all areas residential/commercial/industrial shall operate only with mandatory sound enclosures and other standards prescribed in Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
15. Mobile Generator sets shall operate only if they have installed and adhere to prescribed standards for noise and emission as laid down in Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
16. An area of 100 meters around all Educational Institutions, all Courts, all Govt. Office Complexes, all 100 bedded and above hospitals will treated as "Silence Areas/Zones".
